### 'A Rose By Any Other Name' – Rosana's Signature Drink 20

Hendrick's gin, elderflower, rose, lemon, sparkling wine

*The famous quote from William Shakespeare's 'Romeo and Juliet'. Meaning that it matters what something is, not what it is called.*

### Dry Martini 24

4 Pillars Rare Dry Gin, Noilly Prat, olives

*Lots of legends are around for this cocktail. Someone says it has been created by Professor Jerry Thomas, others say it was called 'Martinez Special' after the bar it was first served. Regardless of the legends, you choose how you like it. Gin or Vodka, dirty or dry, olives or lemon, shaken or stirred.*

### Espresso Martini 18

Wodka Wyborowa, Kahlua, Espresso

*Originated at the Sobo Brasserie in 1983 by Dick Bradsell it was called 'Vodka Espresso' at first.*

### Aperol Spritz 16

Aperol, Prosecco, Soda

*Going to Europe you will find it everywhere but it all started in Venice. The perfect summer drink.*

### Old Fashioned 24

Jameson Irish, bitters, sugar

*1806. That's a year. The time the old fashioned came to life. Referred to at the time as 'bittered sling' it went a long way with lots of variations before it made its way back to the original recipe. Here, we twist it again and use a smooth Irish Whiskey to balance with the aromatic bitterness.*

## COCKTAILS

### Rusty Nail 24

Johnnie Walker Black Label, Drambuie

*This classic originates in Scotland. Its long journey to popularity started in 1937 and it was not before 1963 in Manhattan actually, that the name and drink stuck to the people.*

### Negroni 22

Campari, Bombay Sapphire, Vermouth Rosso

*Its origins are quite unknown but it is reported that it was first mixed in Florence, Italy in 1919. Bartender Fosco Scarselli got asked to strengthen the Americano Cocktail so he added Gin instead of Soda Water and orange instead of lemon peel. A new drink was born.*

### Margarita 18

Olmecca Reposado, Lemon, Cointreau Orange

*First mentioned in the 'Café Royal Cocktail Book' in 1937. You could say it is the Mexican version of a 'Daisy', which is also the translation of Margarita.*

*Many US residents travelled to Mexico for alcohol during prohibition and in 1936 actually there was a newspaper article mentioning the finding of such cocktail.*

### Hugo 16

St. Germain Elderflower, Prosecco, Soda, Mint

*We have been around the globe but now. Austria. In 2005 The Bartender Roland Gruber was looking for an alternative to the Aperol Spritz or Spritz Veneziano. That's when the Hugo was 'conceived'.*

### Manhattan 20

Canadian Club, Vermouth Rosso, bitters

*Popular history suggests that the drink originated at the Manhattan Club in New York City in the mid-1870's, where it was invented by Iain Marshall for a banquet hosted by Jennie Jerome (Lady Randolph Churchill, mother of Winston) in honour of presidential candidate Samuel J. Tilden. The success of the banquet made the drink fashionable, later prompting several people to request the drink by referring to the name of the club where it originated – "the Manhattan cocktail".*

*However, Lady Randolph was in France at the time and pregnant, so the story is likely a fiction.*
